Gift Cards for Afghan Refugees

International Institute was contacted after the Afghanistan evacuation to find out what support interested members of First Congregational Church could offer to incoming refugees. Staff followed up by informing us that they have finalized the manual on their “Community Support Program” and are inviting 5-10 of us to attend a Zoom orientation meeting.

We would like to know who is interested in the Zoom meeting, to learn more about how we can help the Afghani's who are re-settling in St. Louis. We do not know date/time for Zoom meeting and will share that with those interested when we know more.

We are still collecting gift cards through the end of October, when the gift cards will be delivered to the International Institute. Gift cards can be purchased from major grocery stores, chain stores such as Target, Walgreen's, etc. **Global Foods in Kirkwood** is doubling \$25 gift cards (up to a total of \$1500); Global Foods has also stocked up on foods used by Afghanis. You can drop your gift card off at the church; you can also give them to Pat Doyle-Grace or Laura Cooper as they will personally deliver these at the end of the month.
