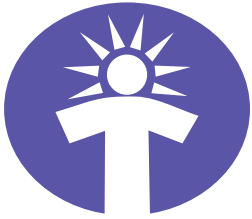

Distribution of Elements and Lighting of Memorial Candles

Instructions for receiving communion and lighting candles: *Maintaining safe social distance (at least 3 feet), please approach the bread and cup from the diagonal aisle nearest your seat, at the indication of an usher, and partake when you receive each (placing the emptied cup in the tray). Bread is gluten free; grape juice is red, wine is white. After the cup, proceed to the altar where you will be handed a candle to light and place in the votive box. Placement of candles begins at the back of the box (nearest the pulpit) so that later worshipers are not burned. When your candle has been placed, please return to your seat by the center aisle.*

Almighty God, we give you thanks for the gift of our Savior's presence in the simplicity and splendor of this holy meal. Unite us with all who are fed by Christ's body and blood that we may faithfully proclaim the good news of your love and that your universal church may be a rainbow of hope in an uncertain world; through Jesus Christ our Redeemer. Amen.
