



Zipporah, described in Numbers 12 as "a Cushite," a biblical word for a sub-Saharan African, was the wife of the prophet Moses (Exodus 2:21-22) and a prophet in her own right: Zipporah appears to have been appalled by the practice of circumcision (Exodus 4:25); she also gave her sons names that protested the Israelites' bondage in Egypt (Exodus 18:2-4).
