

## Internationally Renowned Pianist Nada – Performs in our Sanctuary!

**TODAY at 3:00 pm**

Born in Beirut, Lebanon, Nada is a US citizen of Lebanese/Hungarian descent, with a French education. Nada is one of the most interesting people you will ever meet.

Nada's formation as a pianist was hampered by the unrelenting civil war and terrorism which also cost her mother's life when her Beirut home was shelled. Her family escaped to the mountains where Nada was mainly self-taught. After only seven years of playing the piano, she was admitted to the famous Paris Conservatory where she became the first woman from the Middle East to take First Prize in piano. Since then, she has created a career with tremendous depth and breadth and is celebrated by audiences and critics all over the world.

- Naji Hakim - Variations on a theme by Jean Langlais (2020) written for Pianist Nada
- Robert Schumann - Symphonic Variations op. 13 (edited by Clara Schumann and Johannes Brahms)
- Franz Liszt - Dante Sonata (Fantasia quasi Sonata "After a reading of Dante")
