## Our Whole Lives (OWL) – Sex Ed for Adults: Info Session June 25th in Coffee Hour

Our lovely CE Support Staff Noel Burke will be offering an OWL class for adults starting in September. Our Whole Lives (OWL) is "a comprehensive, lifespan sexuality education curricula for use in both secular settings and faith communities. [It] provides accurate, developmentally appropriate information about a range of topics, including relationships, gender identity and expression, sexual orientation, sexual health, and cultural influences on sexuality."

Halley and Noel will lead this information session. It will be an opportunity to learn about OWL and get your questions answered. Noel will first offer a class to adults only, but ultimately will be offering classes for kids and teens as well. These classes are a "deep dive" and will meet over a period of months (TBD based on participants' schedules).

#### Collecting Signatures For An Important Missouri Legislative Petition

You can help ensure 200,000 Missourians don't have to choose between a paycheck and caring for themselves and their families. Along with other Metropolitan Congregations United (MCU) congregations, we will be collecting signatures for an initiative petition to guarantee earned paid leave plus a raise in the minimum wage in Missouri. With enough signatures, this issue will be on the ballot in Missouri in the fall of 2024.

If you are a registered Missouri voter and want to support getting these issues on the ballot, all you have to do is sign the petition. Doug Miller will be available during the month of June to take your signature on Sunday mornings before and after worship service. The one exception is June 4, when he has other obligations before worship and very limited time afterwards as well. (PLEASE NOTE: your signature on the initiative petition only supports getting the proposed legislation on the ballot. It does not require that you actually vote for the legislation once it is on the ballot.)

If you want to help collect signatures, for example, from family and friends, please talk to Doug about how to get trained to collect signatures and for some background literature and blank petition pages. The training is quite easy both in terms of time commitment and learning time.

We look forward to robust support from FCCWG for this very valuable legislation. Doug Miller
