Aid for First Congregational Church of Spencer, Massachusetts

Roger Barnes is collecting donations for the historic First Congregational Church of Spencer, Massachusetts. The church burned in a horrific fire on June 2nd.

The church was formed in 1744 with the signing of their Covenant by eight members. In 1772, a larger church replaced the original building. This larger church burned on January 1, 1862, and a new structure was built and dedicated in 1863. Many changes and improvements had been made over the years. After 160 years of serving the town, it was this church building that was destroyed by the fire on June 2. The Rev. Dr. Bruce MacLeod is the interim pastor for both this church and their neighbor, the First Congregational Church of Leicester. For now, the members of the Spencer church are worshipping at the Leicester church.

It is important to offer our hand in support of churches that need help, especially those that share our heritage. (On a personal level, Roger reports that he has some Barnes ancestors

buried in the Spencer churchyard.) Roger says, "It would be awesome to show our love to this church in need. Thanks for helping."
