Congregational Meeting, January 19 after worship

The Executive Ministry has called a meeting of the Congregation, for Sunday, January 19 following worship. The agenda for this meeting will include

- Consideration of revisions to the 2025 Budget. Revisions include an increase in staff costs, to cover compensation of our Coordinator of Faith Formation and new Office Administrator, and to recognize the abundant generosity of our Members and friends. In celebration of the 30th anniversary of the VerHagen Memorial sanctuary organ, organist John Powel Walsh will present a program entitled, "The Organ in a New Light." John's experience includes service as organist of the St. Louis Bach Society and the St. Louis Abbey.

His program on February 2 will include music "by composers who should have written more for the organ."
